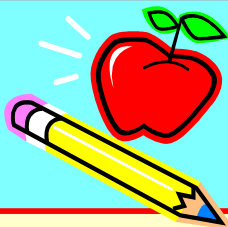

Progress Reports

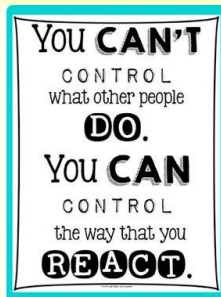
