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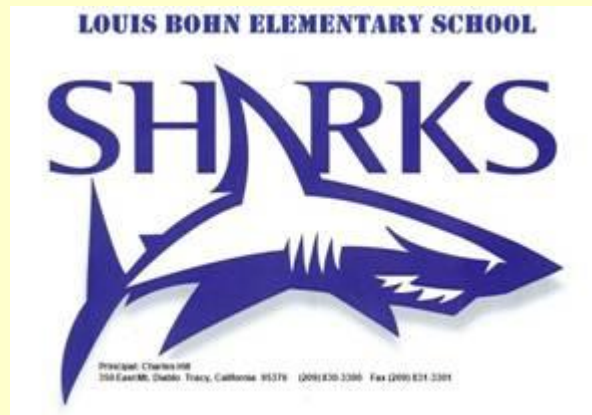

AR Testing

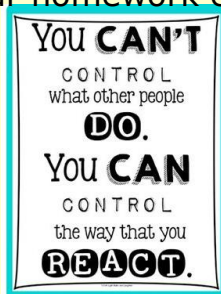
We will take the STAR reading test for AR one more time this year. The results will come home with the report card on Friday, May 26th. This will give you a reading range to help guide your student's summer reading.
