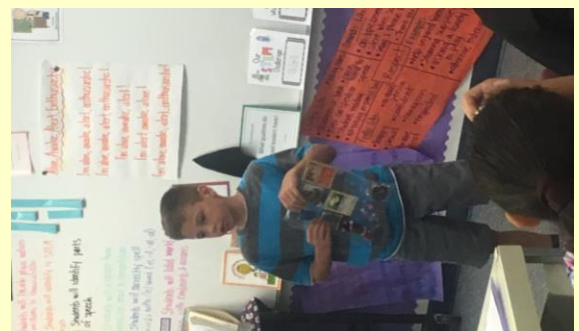
Few Reminders:

Some ways to earn points are on task behavior, participating in class discussions, and being consistent with turning in classwork. Some ways to get points deducted are not being prepared, having missing assignments, or needing redirection throughout the day. These points coincide with our Strikes to Grand Slam Chart. If a base hit is earned, then points can be awarded. Getting a strike can deduct points. We love that we have already begun to see positive behavior to try and earn points.
